 to make recommendations to our church family about church rentals. We will also consider
 how to best give leadership to our children's CE areas of Sunday School, Nursery, AWANA,
 VBS, and Children's Church.
- On August 12, we will enjoy a **baptism and child dedication service** and brunch after our morning service. This will be a really fun Sunday.
- AWANA and Sunday School will start in September.
- I'm looking forward to a series on the book of **James**. Start reading it now!

As for our children's programs, remember that it is not enough to get a pack of children onto the church property for a quality program.

I continue to reflect on how our Vacation Bible School program hit the ball out of the stadium. For a church with our size facilities to average over 100 children per day is quite an achievement. We should all be very thankful for the gift so many of our workers gave to the Lord's work with VBS.

But we also need to ask: "Are we doing our best to coordinate VBS with our fall programs and to make sure that we are moving from children visiting to families being assimilated into the life of our church?" This is one of the areas where we need improvement. We need to *cooordinate* the efforts of our programs to invite guests to AWANA into the life of our church.

Indeed, one of our goals for the coming year will be to increasingly invite visitors to AWANA and VBS to visit our Sunday morning services.

I have prayed for a number of you on my knees today. I am thankful I am your pastor.
