We face a defining year of "brick-laying" in 2019. It is likely that at the Annual Meeting our congregation will vote to forge ahead with a pre-capital campaign assessment. If we get a green-light from that assessment – if our congregation is ready to go --- then we will have a spring capital campaign.

The Bible uses the metaphor that Christians are "living stones" God intends to be mortared together into a spiritual house (1 Peter 2:5). So if you are a Christian, you are a "brick." And God makes "bricks" with a building in mind. We are to be built up together in community.

So what will it look like as we are mortared together in community in 2019? Consider the following images:

**Loving one another** – There always many opportunities to be the hands and feet of Christ. We already know of a cancer battle . . . We will discover what it looks like to give rides, cook meals, give to the benevolent fund . . . I am sad that our people face pain --- but overjoyed with how we will serve and show Christ.

**The Master Plan** – Our plan of outlining how we will use our campus is now coming into clear focus. It is very possible that by the annual meeting (1/27/19 at 4:00 PM) we will be able to show a **picture** of how we will expand our facilities to connect with our community.

A Capital Campaign? – If our membership affirms the direction in January, our church will do a precampaign assessment or feasibility study with Church Growth services in February. In the feasibility study, Bill Walter will interact with our congregation to help us determine if we are ready to go forward with a capital campaign and a building program.

Children's Ministries – Our children's director, Cara Roberts, is helping us be sure that all our children's ministries are in sync with one another. We are praying that in February we can invite children to practice music together for Mother's Day music in May. This should give us the opportunity to invite even more children to Vacation Bible School. We picture using our new green space to the north of our church building to connect with our community at Fall Festival. And before we know it, it will be time for AWANA in the fall!

**Youth and all other ages** – We are encouraging our teens to sign up for camp for the summer of 2019. Our young people need to unplug from this electronic age and be together with other young people where they sing and enjoy Christ together.

But our goal is always to be **intergenerational**. That means our young people will be delivering Valentines to seniors and looking for other ways to connect with the wider body of Christ.

**Adult Education** is firing on all cylinders during both the 9:00 and 10:30 hours. This is a great time to connect more deeply with our church family in one of those classes.

**Finishing the Book of James** – I will finish our current series in the book of James – we still have chapter 5 left --- and then we will be on to a new series. I will be praying in January about our next sermon series.


