Let's continue actively loving one another. Remember this Sunday (3/3) is communion service and benevolent offering.

The verse I often point to in this context is 1 Peter 2:5a. "... you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house." Hearing how people have actively ministered to Elizabeth – whether it is painting her nails or Grace being taken to a Disney production – these are

wonderful, tangible ways we are loving. Jesus said, "By this will all men know that you are my disciples, if you love one another (John 13:34-35)."

I am thankful for our ladies who found out on Saturday morning that we would be preparing a meal to serve 100 people on Monday for Bernice Kruse's funeral luncheon. To put together such an excellent meal in such a short period of time is a credit to the love in our congregation. I am privileged to be one of your pastors.

The Pre-Capital Campaign Assessment (PCCA) report will be given to our leaders on March 12 and the congregation on March 17.



Church Growth Services (CGS) has completed all or nearly all of the interviews of our congregation. The survey has also been conducted. Now CGS will distill and summarize the information that we have given to them and, based on their expertise, give us a red light, a yellow light, or a green light for a possible capital campaign this Spring.

If we go forward with a capital campaign, CGS will recommend a target we should set to raise over a threeyear period of time.

The results of the PCCA will be given to our congregation at a meeting on 3/17 at 4:00PM. If we do receive a green light from CGS, then we will need to formally make a decision as a congregation about whether or not to proceed with a capital campaign immediately.


