August is the New September

The church year begins in August. Sunday, August 11 will be a special youth Sunday with Greg Speck preaching.

God often uses **simple invitations** to church to save people in spectacular ways.

The wording of an invitation to church is straight-forward. You need only say:

If you don't already have a church home, we'd love for you to be our guest. We could sit together and maybe eat together afterwards.

Pray even as you invite someone to church – ask that our gracious God would use your invitation to share the gospel.

When you invite, be prepared to zero in on a particular Sunday. "Close the invitation" by pinning down a date. The dialogue to the above invitation might continue like this:

Potential Guest: I would like to visit your church at some point. That would be nice. We know we need a church home.

You: Well, how about this Sunday, would you come then?

There is no time of the year that it isn't appropriate to invite someone to church. But August is especially ideal. People are often coming off vacation and preparing to begin a new school year.

Greg Speck will be preaching at our church on August 11. Greg is a very, very well-known youth speaker and our young people have enjoyed him on a number of occasions.

Our **Brick by Brick Campaign** continues forward. Our building committee will soon meet with the architect to keep the project going forward. The **timing** of the campaign depends, in part, on how quickly our pledges come in. We hope to break ground as early as spring of 2020. But we should also be aware:

- Our giving towards **General Budget** is behind year-to-date. It is vital that we finish the year as strongly as possible where our general budget is concerned.
- We are facing significant expenses for repairing the brick of our existing building. The
 Trustees are working on those details --- and we have a capital savings fund for such matters
 --- but it will require significant expenditures as it relates to our overall finances.

We are actively pursuing an **associate pastor**. A team of our leaders have interviewed one candidate and we are pursuing more interviews. As is the case with every aspect of church life, **prayer** is an essential ingredient.








CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

With school beginning soon, now is a great time to start getting into a new routine. If you are not currently reading the Bible and praying with your family, I would suggest adding this time into your daily routine. Don't focus on perfection, but aim for progress. There is a resource shelf at the back of the church. It has books that Pastor Chris recommends each family own. You can look at the books, and even take one home to check it out.



This month, I want to highlight a book that is not geared towards children, but parents, if you read this book yourself and implement the suggestions in it, you will be a good example for your children: *Habits of Grace: Enjoying Jesus through the Spiritual Disciplines* by David Mathis. This book teaches us to grow in God's grace rather than trying to rely on our own strength. Mathis states, "I can flip a switch, but I don't provide the electricity. I can turn on a faucet, but I don't make the water flow. There be no light and no liquid refreshment without some else providing it. And so it is with the Christian with the ongoing grace of God. His grace is essential for our spiritual lives, but we don't control the supply. We can't make the favor of God flow, but he has given us circuits to connect and pipes to open expectantly. There are paths along which he has promised his favor." You can order this book from Amazon or Christian book distributor for around \$15.

Vacation Bible School was a huge success. We had a record number of children in attendance averaging over 120 children each day, and raised over \$900 to help buy an oven for our missionary friends the Farmer family. It was a great week for the children in attendance, and the adults and teens who were privileged to help. We invited all of our VBS attenders to join us at church on Sunday. We had 20 children and their families attend church that week that don't normally come to our church! We served donuts and coffee in the basement and all enjoyed a sweet



time of fellowship. A big thanks to Tom and Ashley Stahl for leading another year of VBS. They are amazing! They work so hard to make sure everything is organized and runs smoothly. We also want to thank Grace Church of DuPage for allowing us to borrow their VBS set yet again this year.

SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS ...



It's hard to believe that we are gearing up for fall ministries. Sunday School registration will be available on the church's home webpage the beginning of August. Sunday School begins this year on Sunday, September 8th. Sunday School will operate during the 9:00 am worship service from Labor Day through Memorial Day weekend. Pre-K through 5th grades meet in the church lower level. Junior High (Bible Instruction Class / BIC) as well as the High School Sunday School classes meet in our church administration building. Adult Sunday School will meet in the classroom next to the nursery. There are two adult Sunday School groups that meet. One group meets during the 9:00 am worship service and the second

group meets during the 10:30 am worship service. When there are one service Sundays (Fall Festival weekend, etc.) there will be NO Sunday School on that particular Sunday.

Children's Church is available during the 10:30 am worship service and also when there is only one morning worship service. Children's Church is available for preschool through 1st grade students. Children will begin the worship service with their parents and then are dismissed during the service.
