One of the biggest takeaways from our 9/22 congregational meeting was that we need to raise the level of concern regarding giving to our general budget.

Thirty-two youth and leaders packed into the conference room of the administration building is great incentive for our church to move forward with the building program. It's actually a wonderful atmosphere - the teens have had a tremendous attitude and our leaders have enjoyed the time – but wow are we excited about more space.

There is great reason to believe that we will break ground on the Brick Center in the spring of 2019. As we updated you on Sunday night, our building fund is at \$679,000. We are off and going.

Both interaction during the meeting --- and the feedback through surveys – indicate a very, very strong consensus amongst our congregation that we: (1) Go forward this spring (2) That we continue with our conservative approach financially. (3) That a free-standing building is the first priority – though we continue to be very concerned about our current building.

We are spending money now to repair the bricks. And we plan a face lift on the inside once a new building is completed.

A large percentage of those survey indicated that we need to raise the level of concern about our general budget giving. Please review the numbers given later in the newsletter that our general budget giving is less than our expenses thus far in 2019. It is, of course, vital that we have a strong fourth guarter as we anticipate a very exciting 2020.


### HOLIDAY PLANTER CLASS


