Given our Christmas celebration last year, it's not so hard to picture how much fun we will have this year on December 22. Our church will be crowded.

People will be home for the holidays. The eyes of our children will sparkle with excitement. Chaotic joy.

As a part of worshipping our Savior, a goal of our chaotic joy is to teach our children that God's people should be the most joyful. Christmas is a time when we celebrate central aspects of our faith.

So, what are the truths that we celebrate this Christmas? Here are a select few to remember:

- The incarnation Christmas celebrates the greatest miracle ever, that God became humanity without ceasing to be deity. The importance of the incarnation is stressed in Hebrews (2:14-18) because Jesus became humanity so that he might: (1) Experience death for us (2) Bring us to glory (3) Defeat the devil and the fear of death (4) Become a fully qualified high priest.
- **Grace** God is a gift-giving God. It is appropriate for us to give gifts to one another because in so doing we reflect our Creator.
- **Church Family** We are not called to an individual experience of the faith. Rather, we are part of Christ's church we are brothers and sisters together a family.
- **The Global Gospel** Jesus came as a "light for revelation to the Gentiles," which is to say that God's plan was that the good news of Christ would go out to the ends of the earth.
- **God's heart for humility** Whether it was the circumstances of our King's birth, or the announcement to the lowly shepherds, the Christmas story reminds us that God esteems the humble. The same Isaiah who prophesied, *"For unto us a Son is born . . .,"* also wrote, *"But this is the one to whom I will look: he who is humble and contrite in spirit and trembles at my word* (Isaiah 66:2b).
- Christmas leads to Good Friday and Easter. At Christmas time we focus on the incarnation, but as believers we are always thinking about the Cross where our Savior bore our sins in his body on the tree (1 Peter 2:24).

All these points – and many more – are the basis for our chaotic joy this Christmas season.

### **Associate Pastor Candidate**


