Is failure final?


Maybe.

Going into a new year, it should be said, "Failure may be final. But failure is not necessarily final."

#### What a sobering contrast:

- For some, failure is final, the end: Humpty Dumpty nosedived off the wall, and all the royal forces horses and men can't set things right.
- Others who are turned are "put back together" for the better for all
  of eternity. Like Zacchaeus they come down out of the tree and are
  joyously turned about.

This contrast of extremes raises the question, "What is the difference between final failure and total turnaround? How can I see turnaround?" The one Word answer is "Christ." Jesus is the only one who can turn people around.



But the one-word answer of Christ requires far more explanation. We need to *think* carefully and biblically about the glorious *possibility* of change. After all, Scripture tells us that God gives us all we need for life and godliness through our *knowledge* of Him who called us by his own glory and goodness (2 Peter 1:3).

The goal of the upcoming series, "Hear the Lion Roar," is to biblically analyze how God turns people around by reflecting on the story of Judah and the family of Jacob in Genesis 37-50. Failure may be final for someone you love. But it doesn't necessarily need to be so. Why not invite?

You can prepare for this series in several important ways:

- Pray. Ask God to open your eyes to see glorious things in his Word.
- Read. Spend time in Genesis 37-50.
- Attend. Be here!
- Invite. Ask someone to be your guest.
