Count the ways the view through our NEW windows frames the vision for our church . . . God used so many of YOU to see these windows installed.


The windows are framed in the Brick Center. Today, Pastor David and I looked out through them at Meridian Junior High and the district office.

The pandemic continues to offer lessons in discipleship as we seek to follow Christ faithfully in this unique season. See You at the Pole looked different in practice. Normally students gather around the flagpole at their respective schools to read Scripture, sing songs of praise, and pray during this annual event on the fourth Wednesday in September. 2020 marked the 30th year for this global day of prayer.

In Stillman Valley, God multiplied the event three-fold as there were student gatherings on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday during the week of September 21. Students attending the junior high on Monday and Tuesday this Fall gathered on Tuesday. The senior high met on Wednesday morning, a day when all students in the district are attending class remotely. Wednesday, October 28th


