#### **BRICKS BOUGHT!**

(But we need some paint and lighting also)

The Brick center is paid for! But our building program will continue with phase 2 as we consider how to refresh our sanctuary and gathering space.

We are overjoyed that the Brick Center is completed with zero long-term debt! The new bricks are bought! This will save the Lord's work thousands

of dollars in interest expense.

The Brick Center has already been buzzing with ministry activity. The youth group has leveraged the entire space to meet as a large group, but smaller groups of teens have also met in the classrooms. Mortar Groups are actively meeting in the space. And we recently hosted a missionary presentation with (Ilir and Megan Stamboulli).



We were able to pay off the Brick Center prior to the completion of the Brick by Brick Campaign because we internally approved the building fund borrowing \$80,000 from our general fund. At our church business meeting on 4/25/2021 we acknowledged that our sanctuary needs "attention." Within the context of that meeting, we talked about areas where we need improvement. These included paint, carpet, lighting, accessibility, configuration of the platform, seating, and gathering space.

The need for renovations of our existing building in mind, it is vital that we continue with Brick by Brick giving. Doubtless, we will need the remaining pledges and more as we anticipate the next stage of the building program.

Please review our general giving update in this newsletter and notice that our giving is behind our year-to-date budget target.
