# How Intentional Are You Being with Family Relationships?

Leading our families is one of the most difficult things we do. Yet too often we are not intentional in how we seek to be equipped to influence the people we love. This must change. We must be intentional in seeking to lead. I (Pastor Chris) have spent much time preparing for this series and I'm praying it will be used greatly in families. Please be encouraged: this is not just a series for parents of young children. All of us relate to a family one way or another.

Do we want our children and grandchildren to be blessed? Do we want to experience the favor of God?
