Discipline Not Desire Determines Destiny

A man without self-control is like a city broken into and left without walls. Proverbs 25:28

Let me stress again this month a point of emphasis throughout the Leadership and the Family series, our lives must be protected by discipline.

It doesn't matter what the arena of life, most people long to succeed. Every football player would like to hoist the state championship trophy, just as parents long to bless their children or grandchildren.

Yet the reality is that most people don't really pursue their calling. Many are not defined so much by their aspirations as they are by the day's distractions.

Proverbs emphasizes the importance of discipline. It tells us to picture our lives like a city where there are many invaders. For a city, the primary defense against invasion were walls that could be defended. But for the individual life, our primary defense is not physical walls but rather discipline or self-control.



If we are not disciplined or self-controlled, we will be distracted by our cell phones in between bites of Oreos. I know from personal experience that a row of Oreos can disappear during just one social media session.

The outcome is predictable. An Oreo here, a Fig Newton there, and both our mental and spiritual waistlines expand like the national debt.

All of which is to ask you this question. "In what areas are you seeking to grow in discipline or self-control?"

The believer who is discouraged by a lack of self-control can be encouraged by this truth. Part of the fruit of the Spirit is self-control (Galatians 5:22-23). If you are growing in the Spirit, then the limbs of your life will show the fruit of discipline and there will, in time, be a great harvest.

Grow in your spiritual disciplines (being in church, prayer, worship, Scripture reading) and you will be amazed at the fruit of the Spirit in your life.
