In 2022 there will be a special emphasis on heeding Paul's admonition in 2022 regarding how we are to behave in the household of God – that is the church – including an emphasis on guarding sound doctrine and not being distracted by irreverent babble and contradictions.

* * * * *

Paul concluded 1 Timothy with three sentences that in many ways summarize the entire letter.

²⁰ O Timothy, guard the deposit entrusted to you. Avoid the irreverent babble and contradictions of what is falsely called "knowledge," ²¹ for by professing it some have swerved from the faith. Grace be with you. 1 Timothy 6:20-21

In 2022, there will be a special emphasis in heeding this exhortation. We will do so in several ways.

- 1. **We will preach through 1 Timothy**. While I preached through that letter relatively recently in 2013, there is so much about the book that is timely for 2022 that we will return to it. Be encouraged to read 1 Timothy often. As I have previously pointed out, 1 Timothy 3:14-16 are central verses.
- 2. Studying 1 Timothy provides an ideal context for considering **Constitution Revisions.** We have known for many years that our constitution needed revisions. It's now time. We plan to introduce a draft of proposed revisions at the annual meeting on January 30, 2022. We will then have the year of 2022 to revise and review proposed changes. We will vote on the revisions at the annual meeting in 2023.
 - Constitution changes will not alter the basic ways our church functions. We will remain congregational in our polity (meaning the congregation has final say). But we do need to update several areas.
- 3. Phase 2 of the "Brick by Brick" Campaign It is time to work with an architect to decide how we will update our church building as well as the administrative building. Once we develop a proposed plan for doing so, our leaders (Deacons and Trustees) will decide on a recommendation to phase the plan and we will seek approval from the congregation.
 - It might not hurt to occasionally look at our facilities with a *critical* eye so as to realize that our facilities are not communicating in a way consistent with the excellence of the gospel. (1) Our sanctuary is dated and needs major help with lighting. (2) Our platform needs adjustments for changes in worship. (3) We do not have a foyer. We must consider how to provide gathering space. (4) The Administrative Building badly needs updates throughout.
- 4. The Necessity of a Plurality of Elders Often when churches emphasize the need for a plurality of elders, there is a concern that a small group of people are going to take over the church without accountability. While some of those concerns are legitimate, we must be careful not to throw out God's plan for the local church with the bathwater of stories of disqualified leaders. The flock of Christ needs shepherds who care for the sheep. As I stressed throughout the series on Psalm 23, pastors/elders are called to be the facilitators of Psalm 23. That is, biblical elders are the concrete means God uses to renew the flock and to lead them into green pastures and beside still waters.
