Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God. Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith" (Heb. 13:7).

We will see in our study of Hebrews that Scripture encourages believers to make a special effort to remember those who shared the Word. It is appropriate to reflect on Rod and Linda Wetzig's important ministry at our church.

Pastor Rod Wetzig passed away from a neurological infection early on Friday morning, July 7, 2023. Linda was with him, and he was a wonderful witness to the grace of God to the end of his life.

Rod and Linda served at our church from January 1994 to July 2003 and was one of the longest serving pastors in our church's 165-year history.

Rod was a gifted musician who used his voice to encourage both congregationally and in private pastoral contexts.

Rod is also remembered as particularly gifted in compassion and care. He walked through some very deep valleys with our church family. I recall Leonard Carmichael sharing how Rod shepherded them through the valley of losing a son suddenly. Rod's wife, Linda, likewise, is warmly remembered for her love for the flock.

Some of our long-term members like Pete Mazanec or Carol Brauer (and a number of others) have *many* memories of Rod and Linda's time in our church.

Rod and Linda came to our church at a difficult time. The previous pastor served less than two years. The Wetzig's gently and lovingly built into people's lives and enjoyed sharing life with the flock. During their time, a great deal of healing took place.

I spoke with Linda the Monday after Rod went into the presence of the Lord. Looking back over their years of ministry, she and Rod had realized that God's particular call on their lives was to build up hurting churches. In all, Rod served in five different churches including churches in New York, Illinois, Iowa, Nebraska, and Wisconsin.

It would be difficult to list right now all the ways God is currently blessing our church. Our attendance numbers are very strong. Multiple young people have been to camp or are at camp. We had a baptism service on July 2 and welcomed new members. Our constitution has been revised, the most demanding phase of the Brick-by-Brick campaign is completed, and we are in a strong place financially. The gospel is proclaimed, and God is worshiped each week. The glory belongs to God. But God works through the instrumentality of people in general and pastors in a particular way (Ephesians 4:11-12). Apart from Rod Wetzig's leadership, our church would not have been positioned to witness God's grace in the many ways we have seen it across the twenty years since he left.






LOCAL MISSIONS OPPORTUNITY!
