### Will You Complete a Hebrews Assignment?

Complete a Hebrews assignment by 10/15/23 that will serve both yourself and the preaching of the Word.

This Fall we are beginning an extended series in Hebrews. The goal is not simply that I (Pastor Chris Brauns) preach through Hebrews in a linear way. We are praying that our church family is *deeply* encouraged by meditating on the whole book.

Would you accept a challenge as a part of this project? If you participate, it will help both yourself and those preaching on Hebrews.

Here is the assignment. Electronically or physically return a sheet to me that documents you did the following:

- 1. Read Hebrews three times. Write down your dates of completion.
- 2. Identified 3 favorite verses or short passages (2-3 verses) that resonate with you on some level. Write them out.
- 3. Listed 5 terms that a person should know to be able to understand the book of Hebrews. Imagine you are reading Hebrews with no Christian background. What categories would you need to investigate to understand the book?
- 4. Identified 5 people other than Jesus of interest in the book of Hebrews.
- 5. Wrote out 2-3 questions you have about the book of Hebrews.
- 6. **Read the ESV Study Bible Introduction of Hebrews**. If you don't have an ESV Study Bible, copies of the Hebrews introduction (about 3 pages) will be available at church.
- 7. Prayed on at lead three occasions that you prayed for this series. Write down the dates.

Your completion of this assignment (**by 10/15/23**) will serve the preaching of the Word on multiple levels! I will gain a window into your thinking. I will be encouraged that you are reading the Word. Your heart and mind will be prepared. And we will have prayed.

#### Who would you invite to church this Fall?

Life outside the church is as dangerous as life outside the Ark was in the days of Noah.

Reflect on the image of being outside the Ark. What a dreadful place.

And – likewise it is clear to be paddling around outside of a local church is to be figuratively in the "rain of a fallen world." While it is possible that someone can be born again and not be actively involved in a local church, the local church is where God promised he would strengthen and nourish believers so that they can make their way through a fallen world.

Do you know someone who has drifted away? God might use a simple phone call in an eternal way.

We were greeted by BJ Bechtel, Chief Executive Officer for the ministry. ICI serves families in the neighborhood by providing children and teenagers a safe place for them to go throughout the year. Their programming lets them engage in play, build healthy relationships, expand their self-worth, and develop life skills including tutoring. Their tag, "Learn. Live. Lead." summarizes their focus all with a goal of introducing them to Jesus, discipling young believers, and helping them find a local church.


My family served that day by packing school supply boxes. ICI planned to distribute them at an event in their parking lot the following week.

The goal of our visit was to establish a connection with the ministry for the purpose of planning a week of service on location next summer. The Evangelical Free Church of Mount Morris has brought a group of young people to ICI several times in recent years. This ministry has become a highlight of the summer for many of them.


What would a week of service at ICI look like? Living on site for the week, we will be responsible for facilitating their summer day camp. Their facility includes a full-service commercial kitchen and bathrooms with showers. Children arrive late Monday morning and move through several stations including Bible lesson, crafts, tutoring, and games, eating lunch along the way. Day camp concludes in the late afternoon. We will have time to prepare and eat dinner, debrief as a ministry team, prepare for the next day, have some fun, and get some rest.

Would you begin to pray as we seek to make this a part of our summer 2024 plans at the Red Brick Church? Perhaps you will join us. One church travels from out of state to ICI. Families with children of all ages come and they found it to be a great way to spend a week. Young children participate with neighborhood children in the day camp while parents and teens serve.
