
All Boards and Committees will be meeting in February to elect new officers and chairmen. Chairmen of all committees and phone numbers will be printed in the March 2024 Newsletter.

A man without self-control is like a city broken into and left without walls. Proverbs 25:28

On the evening of Thursday, January 25, 2024, twenty-eight men of the Red Brick Church gathered in the Brick Center for a Mortar Group meeting. Many around the room met someone new as we introduced ourselves. Only one dated his time at the church to before the millennium and only one was born after it.

We reflected on the subject of a heroic man and brainstormed no fewer than 38 characteristics of a truly heroic man. Following that exercise, we continued our time in Proverbs 25. Men hearing other men read God's Word was powerful and a discussion of what we heard proved profitable. We also brainstormed ideas for future discussions and studies.


