September kicks off AWANA and other Fall ministries.

We can already feel it on a cool, crisp late summer morning. Fall is coming. Ministries at The Red Brick Church will be in full swing. September kicks off AWANA and other Fall ministries.

The men have already led the way with a successful Men's Mortar Group meeting on Thursday, August 29 in the Brick Center. We have nine more meetings scheduled before the end of May 2025.

Two sessions of the fall ladies Bible study begin the week of September 2: Tuesday evenings, 6:30 to 8 and Thursday mornings, 9 to 10:30. More than 50 women have registered to participate between the two groups!

AWANA kick-off is Wednesday, September 4. The missionary featured this year is the Sponholz Family serving at Lake Lundgren Bible Camp in Pembine, Wisconsin.

Sunday School for all ages begins Sunday, September 8. For adults, the 9 o'clock Mortar Group will resume meeting in the Adult Sunday School Room and the 10:30 Mortar Group will continue to meet in the Brick Center. We will have two services through mid-May (with few exceptions – Fall Festival 9/29, Christmas Gift Exchange 12/22, and 12/29) to facilitate the additional activity on the church campus every Sunday morning.

Youth Bible study is joined by activities such as the See You at the Pole Rally on Sunday, September 15 and See You at the Pole on Wednesday, September 25. In October, we bring back College and Military Care Packages and Around the Table with Seniors and Teens.



We will be having a luncheon for our SS children and prayer partners on Sunday, November 10th immediately following the 2nd worship service in the Brick Center. Lunch will be provided.




Fall Ladies Bible Study have started!

If you were unable to be with us for our first study, we would encourage you to still join one of the studies!!


